**Dr. Witaya Chadbunchachai received his training in General Surgery at Faculty of Medicine, Khon Kaen University after graduated from Faculty of Medicine Siriraj Hospital in 1977. He is presently working at Khon Kaen Regional Hospital. His interest includes accident and emergency services. He received his further training in Traumatology at Alfred Hospital, Monash University, Australia in 1993 and Emergency Medicine Services of JICA, Japan in 1995. He improved the Trauma System in Khon Kaen Province by setting up the Emergency Medicine Service System in the city. He also established the Trauma Registry and Trauma Audit at the Khon Kaen Hospital.**

He has served in many important positions at Khon Kaen Hospital, National Safety Council, Ministry of Public Health and WHO.
